

Training Background

Beginning July 2010, if an individual convicted of domestic battery is ordered to attend a Batterers' Intervention Program as a condition of sentence, House Enrollment Act 1234 states that the BIP must be certified. Currently, the Indiana Coalition Against Domestic Violence is the certifying body. *The BIP Institute* is a training designed by the BIP Standards Committee of ICADV to assist batterers' intervention programs not currently certified by ICADV in obtaining certification. Per the certification standards, all individuals wishing to facilitate a certified BIP group must have 40 hours of training specifically addressing issues of domestic violence. This training will provide 24 of the 40 hours necessary to become a certified facilitator. In addition, ICADV offers other training opportunities throughout the year to help individuals meet those required educational hours.

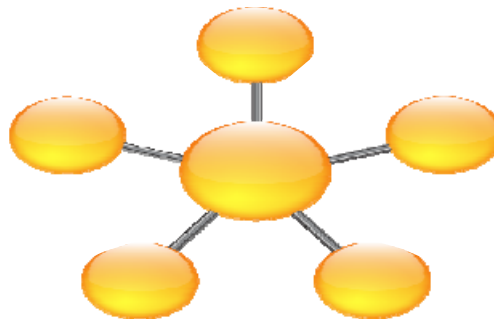
