Colleen Yeakle, MSW **Coordinator of Prevention Initiatives;** **ICADV**

Colleen has worked as an advocate serving survivors of domestic and sexual violence for over 11 years. She began her service as an AmeriCorps member working in a transitional housing program with formerly homeless women & children with histories of domestic violence. From there, Colleen moved to a position coordinating crisis intervention and prevention services for Middle Way House, a domestic violence program & rape crisis center in Bloomington. Colleen provided on-scene support for victims seeking medical care. She balanced this intervention work with prevention by collaborating with community partners to implement social norms campaigns designed to reduce the incidence of violence. Colleen currently serves as the Coordinator of Prevention Initiatives for the Indiana Coalition Against Domestic Violence.

Colleen holds a Bachelor's Degree in Arts and a Master's Degree in Social Work from Indiana University.

Caryn C Burton, MS **Training Director; ICADV**

Caryn graduated with her BA in psychology and communications from Butler University in 1999. She earned her MS in Counseling with an emphasis in the school setting, also through Butler University, in May of 2007. After earning her undergraduate degree, Caryn completed a one-year term of service with AmeriCorps, working with Legal Services of Indiana. She went on from there to direct the IndyCorps program for three years, supervising 90 service members. She worked in direct victims services for eight years as both an outreach and court advocate and as the director of a transitional housing program. Currently, Caryn is on staff at The Indiana Coalition Against Domestic Violence as their training director, holding that position since January of 2007.
