Your answers on these forms are very important! They can affect the protections and assistance the court may provide, but some questions are difficult to answer. The clerks in the court's office can help you with completing the basic information, and they may be able to describe the type of information that is requested in other questions. However, the clerks cannot help you decide what the best choices and options are for you in your particular situation.

These questions in particular should be **carefully** answered:

- Your public mailing address.
- The acts of violence the abuser has committed.
- Descriptions of the incidents: what happened, dates, witnesses.
- The relief requested (the types of protections and assistance you need).
